Personal Survival Items for Winter Travel

Exercise Caution using candles or a stove in a stranded vehicle. Open proper ventilation and do not leave on when Sleeping or for extended periods. Carbon Monoxide is a very real danger in that situation.

Do not leave engine running for more than 10 minutes per hour for the same reason.

AVOID Carbon Monoxide poisoning!

- Storage Box or Bag
- Blankets / Sleeping Bags
- Candles
- Matches / Lighter
- Drinking Water
- Back Packing Stove
- Fuel Bottles for Back Packing Stove
- Power Bars / Food Bars
- Freeze Dried Back Packing Rations
- Dog Food (If you are likely to have the pup along)
- Extra - DRY - Socks and wool gloves
- Extra Clothing (Winter Coveralls?)

Non-Lethal Defensive Options

- Pepper Spray
- "Taser" Type Defense Tool
- Compressed Air Horn (Super Loud)
- **Lethal Options are a Personal Choice**
